

Some key supports for SMMEs during GEW2020


- 1. We ensured that entrepreneurs received skills they need to rebuild and grow their business during and after the crisis.
- 2. There were on average 50 SMMEs participating in the masterclass daily.
- 3. Polokwane municipality department of local economic development organised a group of 40 SMMEs operating locally to participate in the virtual sessions daily.
- 4. We identified high-impact businesses in Exxaro Resources' host communities through virtual pitching process, 6 of them were awarded cash prize as grant funding.



GEW2020 programme virtual sessions

All the masterclass sessions were virtual, time was 9H00 - 11H00 daily. Virtual pitching competition kicked off on Wednesday 18th till Friday 20th. Entrepreneurs in Limpopo and Mpumalanga ONLY submitted a 120 seconds pitch video online tagging @67CEOS and #PoweringPossibility.

We received 15 entries, did the adjudication on Saturday 21st and 6 winners were selected, 3 SMMEs per province (Limpopo and Mpumalanga) and were awarded a total of R200,000 cash prize each.


